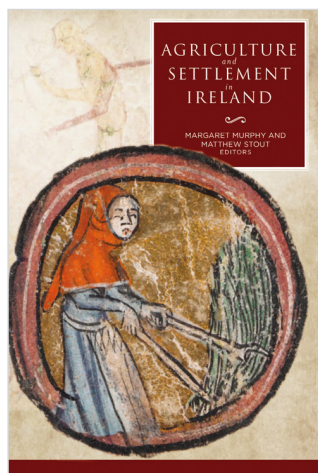

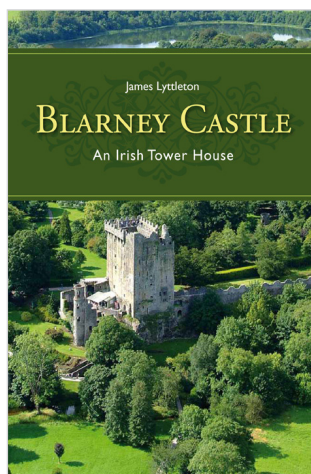


## Agriculture and Settlement in Ireland
