The Disert Archaeological Field School in Co. Donegal, Ireland offers the unique opportunity for students to perform the initial excavation at this isolated pilgrimage site. Reportedly founded by St. Colmcille in the 6th century AD, the townland of Disert is situated in a rural part of Ireland within the foothills of the beautiful Bluestack Mountains. While working alongside Irish students and local community members, participants will gain valuable field experience in excavation, survey, and site recording. Students will also be introduced to the rich culture and history of Ireland.
